**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF REAL ESTATE**

WHEREAS, the City desires to sell said parcels; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined the value of the parcels and has received an offer commensurate with the determined value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF PEVELY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor or City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City to secure the sale of the parcels of real estate, more specifically described in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. The Mayor and the officers, agents, and employees of the City are hereby authorized and directed to take such further action and execute such other documents, certificates, and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the terms of the proposed sale of the parcels identified in Exhibit A.
